*PRAYER OF CONFESSION


Our prayer of confession is followed by a time for silent confession.

POSTLUDE – Toccata on Llanfylln

This Morning's Music: Acknowledges the call to action that God places in our lives and the adoration that is warranted from our lips. The anthem is based on the hymn, "The God of Abraham Praise" and creates a triumphant choral arrangement that takes inspiration from the opening verse, "The God of Abraham praise, who reins enthroned above." The arrangement also features a soaring soprano descant that harkens the celestial image of angels as mentioned in the fourth verse, "The God who reigns on high the great archangels sing, and 'Holy, holy, holy!' cry 'Almighty King!." The offertory is composed by major American composer and organist, Leo Sowerby (1895-1967), and is a choral setting of Psalm 121. Sowerby's setting of God's steadfast protection is a reflective, choral meditation that opens with an alto soloist who provides the main melody of which the piece is built upon. As the psalm progresses, the choral writing becomes more harmonically expansive to emphasize God's wide breadth of security and guidance, before returning to the solo texture that began the piece.
