The choir splits between treble and baritone voices in various verses before rejoining in the choral refrain: "Praise to thee, O Lord, for all creation. Give us thankful hearts, that we may see: All the gifts we share, and ev'ry blessing. All things come of thee." The offertory is a choral setting of a Shaker hymn by Sid Davis, with the tune first introduced by the baritone voices. The melody further develops as the choir enters in respective harmony, singing from John 4: 4 19-21, stating, "If ye love not each other in daily communion, how can ye love God, whom ye have not seen?"


**Infant and toddler room:** Is available in room 112 during the service should you prefer to leave your child with our wonderful caregivers.





