THIS MORNING'S MUSIC

The anthem is John Rutter's interpretation of a well-known hymn text by F. S. Pierpoint. John Rutter (b. 1945) has been writing, arranging, and publishing choral music since his undergraduate days at Clare College, Cambridge. Last week's coronation ceremony at Westminster Abbey featured several of his arrangements. "For the Beauty of the Earth" allows the soprano voices to soar on the refrains, has a bubbly accompaniment, and offers a jaunty syncopation whenever the choir sings "this our joyful hymn of praise."

The music during the offering was composed by Gordon Young (1919-1998), who for many years was organist and choir director at First Presbyterian Church in Detroit. (First Presbyterian's church building now houses the Ecumenical Theological Seminary.) Young was a prolific composer of organ and choral music, publishing over 800 works. His funeral was held here at GPMC, and his remains are interred in Barbour Chapel.




