**This Morning's Music:** Lift's a joyful noise unto the Lord as we celebrate the 25th anniversary of Pastor Jeff's ordination! The duet this morning is an excerpt from Henry Purcell's (1659-1695) work "Come Ye, Sons of Art" written near the end of the composer's life in 1694 as a multi-movement ode to celebrate the birthday of Queen Mary II of England. The movement heard today features two soloists in imitative jubilee, as the text paraphrases Psalm 150, sounding trumpets and oboes to "Celebrate the Glories of This Day." The anthem is a grand arrangement for brass, organ, and choir on the triumphant hymn "Come, Thou Almighty King" based on the tune, "Italian Hymn" by composer and violinist Felice de Giardini (1716-1796). The service concludes with "Be Thou My Vision," as it is one of Pastor Jeff's personally favorite hymns that has aided his inspiration during his 25 years of ministry and service.
