CARILLON PRELUDE

This Morning's Music: Welcomes the Sanctuary Choir back up in the loft with anthems of praise and adoration! "Now Let Us All Praise God and Sing" is an anthem composed by the late Gordon Young (1919-1998) who served at First Presbyterian Church in Detroit as their organist and choir master. During his time in the Detroit-Metro area, he befriended the congregation at Grosse Pointe Memorial. After his passing, his ashes were interred in the Barbour Chapel Columbarium. It's a fitting welcome back for the choir to pay homage to a local and prominent contributor to American church music.

The Offertory is a Latin motet set to the text of Philippians 2: 10-11 by renaissance composer Jacob Gallus-Handl (1550-1591). His compositional style leans in the direction of the late 16th century school of polyphony, using less vocal independence in imitation, and building more on the fundamentals of harmony and chromatic movement in voices.


