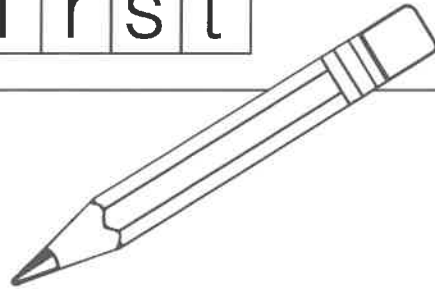

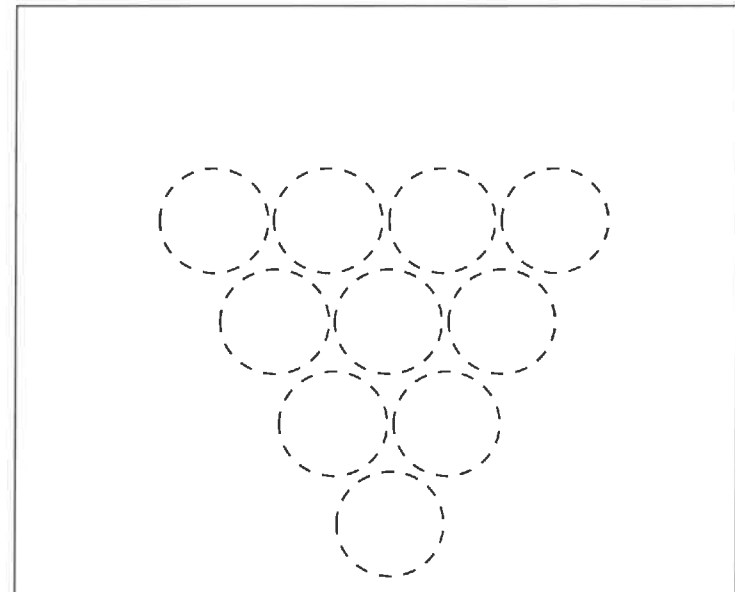
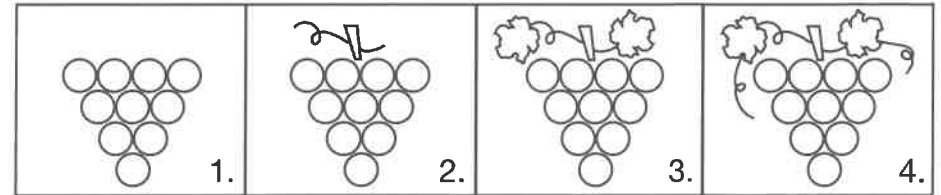

The Workers in the Vineyard

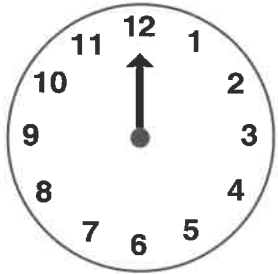
A landowner went early to hire workers for his vineyard.

Follow the steps to draw the grapes.

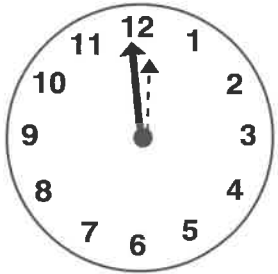


He went to the marketplace at different times to find more workers for his vineyard.

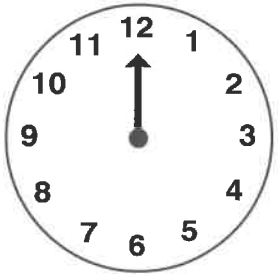
Trace the numbers. Draw a minute hand on each clock to show the correct time.



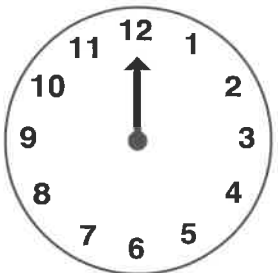

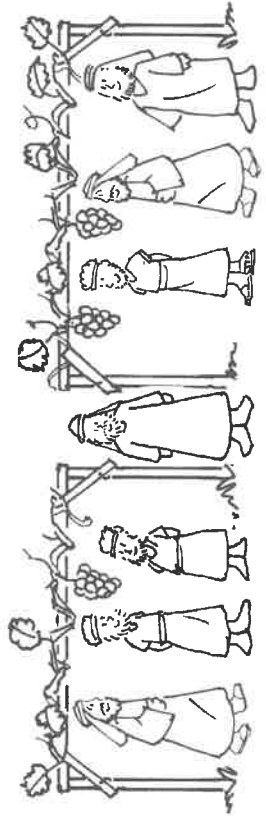

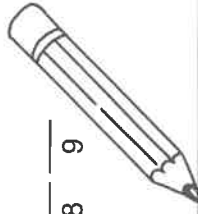
