### What is the congregation's or organization's vision for ministry:

GPMC's vision is "an engaged community of faith, celebrating and demonstrating God's love through worship and service throughout Grosse Pointe, the greater Detroit area and around the world."

JOYFUL WORSHIP - Two traditional services and a third informal service. Multiple weekly Bible studies led by lay leaders and clergy. LOGOS/Youth programs meet weekly. Music Ministry presents enriching music. Summer worship includes lakeside services.

GRACIOUS HOSPITALITY - GPMC is committed to being an inclusive and welcoming environment for all. Deacons greet and nurture. Endowed Ecumenical Minister program hosts international leaders. "Older, Wiser, Learning Still" enriches seniors. Childcare staff enables young families to participate fully. Members support a diverse range of community groups from Boy Scouts to AA.

LOVING SUPPORT - Active Stephen Ministry program. Outreach programs include multi-generational mission trips/service abroad and nationally. Local hands-on service opportunities to our neighbors including hosting annual Shelter Week, Our 313 Calling, Second Mile Center, Everyone Eats, Habitat for Humanity, and Life Remodeled.

## How do you feel called to reach out to address the emerging needs of your community or constituency:

GPMC is dedicated to serving our members and neighbors locally and globally. Our pastor will work with us to enhance our strategy of encouraging more congregational involvement in the life of our church. Additionally, our congregation is committed to addressing the societal needs magnified in light of the pandemic.

Our congregation carries Christ's message both internally to our church body and externally to the community through its involvement in numerous outreach activities including packing 75,000 meals for Kids Coalition Against Hunger, serving over 4,400 meals a year at a local soup kitchen, and founding the "Our 313 Calling" act of kindness program.

GPMC's recent capital campaigns funded restoration and enhancements to the historic lakeside building and grounds which have allowed us to better serve the community. These include the installation of showers and kitchen upgrades to host mission teams and the homeless during Shelter Week. The PHOS will encourage the spiritual growth of the lay leadership and staff to support the goals and vision of the congregation. This individual will need the ability to inspire and lead change while keeping the church focused on its vision for the future. By empowering the leadership and members of the congregation, the PHOS will foster supporting one another lovingly while leading us as we faithfully serve our community.
