Volunteer Job Description*

Youth Mission Trip Advisor

Overview: The Youth Mission Trip supports the church's mission to "continue God's transforming work by worshipping God joyfully, welcoming others graciously, supporting one another lovingly, and faithfully responding to our community and world with compassion." A youth mission trip advisor supports the church's mission to shine Christ's light in the world by supporting opportunities for youth to serve Christ through serving their neighbors, locally, nationally and/or internationally.

Responsibilities:

- Pray for the students, families, and leaders involved in the mission trip.
- Be familiar with the role expectations.
- Communicate in a timely manner with the youth director to whom you're responsible.
- Uphold all safety protocols and procedures leading up to and during the mission trip.
 - Know and follow guidelines established for worksites
 - Be confident in emergency response procedures and your role in them
 - Complete required child protection training
- Be willing to dedicate significant time (usually 1 week) away from home to be on the trip site.
 - Attend pre-event training and team building activities with youth
- Create and foster an environment of welcome, excitement, and commitment to serving others.

Relationships:

- Youth mission trip advisors report to the Youth Director who ensures the support needed to thrive in this role, including mentoring for leadership development, consistent and clear communication, support to build teams and improve systems and processes.
- This role provides support to the youth as they work to accomplish the service project goals.

Time Commitment:

- One week during June, a few hours occasionally during mission trip preparation (usually Oct-June)

Special Talents, Skills Preferred: Passion for justice and/or specific populations or causes, administration, leadership, mercy, wisdom, discernment, cultural and emotional intelligence, calm under pressure, basic first-aid, physical ability to do mission work, child protection training
