Parent Connection Support

Overview: Parent Connection supports the church's mission to "continue God's transforming work by worshipping God joyfully, welcoming others graciously, supporting one another lovingly, and faithfully responding to our community and world with compassion." Parent Connection is the faith formation group for parents of primarily elementary aged children. The group meets monthly for a meal, children's programming, and parent conversation. Volunteers can help by providing a meal, cleaning-up after the meal, or assisting with the children's programming alongside the children's ministry director.

Responsibilities:

- Provide a meal
- Assist with cleaning the kitchen following dinner
- Childcare support for the children's ministry director
- Ensure allergy-free and gluten-free options are provided if notified of those concerns by the Associate Pastor
- Uphold safety protocols

Relationships:

- The Parent Connection support volunteer will work directly with the Associate Pastor and the Children's Ministry Director to know what needs are required each month

Time Commitment:

- 1-2 hours per month
